

Florida Mandatory CLE Requirements

Attorneys must complete 30 credits, including 5 credits in legal ethics, professionalism, mental illness awareness, or substance abuse, during each three-year reporting period. All 30 credits may be earned through interactive computer-based credit.

Using the SVSA VA Accreditation Course for 3.5 Hours of CLE in Florida

This course is accredited by The Florida Bar for 3.5 general CLE credits.

To receive 3.5 hours of CLE in Florida:

1. Finish the course and be certain to write down the three verification codes and the VA course number announced during the course.
2. When finished with the course, go to www.CLEfeedback.com and submit our short evaluation form. In the box entitled 'Verification Codes' write the verification codes and the VA course number so we know that you have completed the course. in the box entitled 'State Bar Number' include your Florida Bar number in this box. Florida requires that we track our participants. You will not receive credit unless you submit these correct codes.

When we receive the submitted evaluation form *with* the correct tracking numbers then we will email you our course reference number issued to us by The Florida Bar. You will be able to use this reference number to go online to www.floridabar.org to report your completion of this program.

The SVSA is not responsible for any loss of credit due to the attorney's own decision to not complete or follow any of the instructions above.

Note: You are still responsible for mailing in your certificate of completion to the Department of Veterans Affairs to receive credit with them.
